No traffic snarls, no worries about parking - patrons simply purchase a return rail ticket and an Ekka entry ticket from any of Citytrain's attended station.

They can then travel from their home station to either Roma Street, Central or Brunswick Street Stations to connect with one of the regular Ekka loop services.

Ekka trains depart every 10 to 15 minutes from these three inner city stations and go directly to the Exhibition platform, where patrons can step off ready for a day of non-stop entertainment.
