## **GOOD WEATHER BRINGS THE CROWDS**

Perfect blue skies and warm sunny weather have brought hundreds of thousands of visitors to this year's EKKA, making it one of the most popular Shows in recent times.

Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland (RNA) President Dr Vivian Edwards OAM said attendance levels for the first seven days of the EKKA were strong.

"The wonderful weather together with our fabulous program have brought people in droves to the EKKA this year," Dr Edwards said.
