- Cabbage
- Cauliflower
- Cucumbers (Group of 3)
- Squash

All entries must be grown by the exhibitor and all categories (except for beans, which are judged by length) will be judged by weight.

All you need to do is:

- 1. Grow a big fruit or vegetable in your garden
- 2. Pay an entry fee of \$5 per entry per exhibit
- 3. Complete an entry form which you can get by contacting the RNA on 07 3253 3920 or by downloading from the EkkA website under competitions www.ekka.com.au
- 4. Deliver your fruit or vegetable (together with the entry form and entry fee) to the RNA Showgrounds Agricultural Hall on Saturday 5th August or Sunday 6th August (depending on your section) between 8.30am and 3.30pm

Judging will take place on Thursday 10th August at the EkkA.
