Gourd! Ekka's giant pumpkins set to squash records

<u>Tomorrow</u> the true heavyweights of the veggie patch will take to the scales with the Royal Queensland Show (Ekka) set to crown the Champion Heaviest Giant Pumpkin of Show.

We understand some of the pumpkins have really packed on the pounds this year, so records may once again be squashed.

Minden farmer, Geoff Frohloff, is hoping to take out the top gong in extreme gardening for a third year in a row– his entry last year weighed in at a record 261.5kg! – that's more than a quarter of a tonne!

For the past three years, the Ekka's iconic Giant Pumpkin Competition has been held outside of August to allow growers to take advantage of the premium growing season, leading to larger than life giant orange vegetables.

Horticulture dates back to the first show held in 1876 and special Atlantic Giant Pumpkin seeds are distributed for free at the Ekka each year, for those keen on getting their green thumbs on.
