Judging will be performed by a panel of Judges appointed by the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland.

The RNA reserves the right at all times at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason to:

- (a) substitute a Judge when necessary;
- (b) re-allocate Judging days for a particular breed.
- (c) if entries numbers require an extra Judge, appoint an additional Judge if necessary.

The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971, and to the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Association, in addition to the Special Regulations which appear in this schedule. Copies of the Rules and By-Laws may be obtained upon application to the Competitions Department.

No refunds will be made after close of entry.

Entries submitted other than on the correct form or online will be returned to the Exhibitor and, unless all requirements are complied with and the forms returned to the office by 5.00pm on the Application to Enter closing date, as shown in the Schedule, they will not be considered.

### ENTRY FORMS

Exhibitors must complete "STATEMENT BY EXHIBITOR" section on the front page of the entry form advising their taxation status.

### PRIZE MONEY

Prize Money stated in the Schedule excludes GST.

GST will be added to the Prize Money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. Prize money will be paid into your nominated bank account by the end October 2018.

The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

All cash prizes and trophies must be claimed within six months from the closing date of the Royal Queensland Show. Prizes not claimed and prize cheques not presented by that date will be considered to have lapsed, and the amount will become a donation to the Association. (RNA By-Laws)

### WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

1. The Brisbane Showgrounds are a designated Workplace within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or sub-contractors, comply with all requirements of the Act and the RNA holds each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during

occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the Showgrounds.

2. Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, RNA staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.
3. Risks identified by exhibitors/competitors will be eliminated or controlled by the exhibitor/competitor and particular attention will be paid to ensuring public safety and safety of other exhibitors/competitors.
4. Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. A "No Smoking Policy" will be strictly adhered to and policed by exhibitors/competitors and exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in the pavilions.
6. Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.
7. All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the Act and its Regulations and Standards in every other respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Royal Queensland Show.
8. The Brisbane Showgrounds is subject to a Special Facility License issued under the Liquor Act 1992 and strict laws related to the consumption and possession of liquor across the Brisbane Showgrounds site. The consumption or possession of liquor outside of the licensed bar areas is not authorised by the RNA and in many cases may be an offence for which on the spot fines can be issued by Police and Liquor Licensing Investigators.

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The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to the following extracts from the RNA By-Laws.

### COMMISSION ON SALES

119. The Council or Executive Committee may from time to time set a commission payable to the Association by the Sellers or their Agents on all sales of Exhibits, affected either by auction or privately, wither on the Ground or elsewhere, during the period of the Royal Queensland Show.

# PRIME LAMBS supported by CAREY BROS. ABATTOIR

In 2018, Exhibitors may drop off their lambs to the Warwick Saleyards (McEvoy St Warwick), for delivery to Carey Bros Yangan by 1pm on Wednesday 8th August 2018. This will enable those exhibitors who wish to compete in the Prime lamb competition and attending the Warwick Pig and Lamb sale to leave their lambs at a designated area.

1. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST NOMINATE AN ACCREDITED SELLING AGENT AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.** Payments will be processed through your nominated agent who will be invoiced by Carey Bros. A commission of 1% on sales shall be paid to the Association by the sellers or their agents. (Attention is drawn to the Association's By-Law No. 119)
2. **Exhibitors must nominate if the animals are 'Grass Fed' or 'Lot Fed' at the time of entry.**
3. Only three entries may be made per class by an exhibitor.
4. Stewards have the right to transfer any entry, that does not conform to class specifications, into the correct class.
5. **Animals no longer displaying lambs teeth will be disqualified.**
6. All exhibits must have been the property of the exhibitor for at least 6 weeks prior to the time of judging.
7. All exhibits in the Carcass Classes must be delivered to Carey Bros Abattoir Yangan by **4.00pm on Wednesday 8 August 2018**. Lambs will be processed on **Thursday 9 August 2018** and judging of carcasses will take place on **Thursday 9 August 2018**. Nb. Exhibitors may leave their animals at the Warwick Pig and Lamb Saleyards (McEvoy St Warwick) by 1pm Wednesday 8 August for delivery to Carey Bros at Yangan prior to processing.
8. With the exception of the First and Second placegetters in each class the lamb carcasses will be purchased by winning tenders at current commercial rates.
9. Every endeavour will be made to showcase the First and Second placegetters from each class in a meat display during the Royal Queensland Show. Carcasses will be open auctioned during the prime cattle sale on Friday 10 August 2018.
10. All exhibits must be clearly marked with a specific number, preferably with an ear tag. Exhibitors will be contacted and informed of this number soon after the close of entries.
11. Exhibitors are asked to please contact the RNA Competitions Department (07 3253 3900) of any withdrawals **24 hours** prior to Monday 6 August 2018.
12. If the nominated agent cannot attend the Prime Lamb Auction, it is the responsibility of the agent to renominate an alternative agent. The RNA must be advised of the change.
