# Galloping into Super Sundae

The Royal Queensland Show's (Ekka) big first weekend got off to a cracker start today with perfect weather as His Excellency General the Honourable Sir Peter Cosgrove AK MC (Retd) Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia officially opened the show.

The final day of Australia's largest beef competition wound up after six days of judging while the prettiest cats of show showcased their luscious locks in the long haired cat judging – tomorrow the shorthair kittens get their turn in the judging ring.

### SADDLE UP - THE BIG BOYS TAKE OVER THE MAIN ARENA

Tomorrow, from 8am, the Ekka's anticipated Horse Competition will take over the Main Arena for seven days of judging and events. The competition has attracted more than 2,400 entries across the horse section, Showjumping and Thoroughbreds, Tomorrow the biggest horse breeds take centre stage with Clydesdales, Shire Horses and Percherons from 9am. Also featuring is the Lady Rider Turnout in Side Saddle and Junior Rider Side Saddle from 2pm. DON'T FORGET - For the very first time, Ekka guests will be able to go onto the Main Arena tomorrow to watch the Horse Competition being judged. They'll get up close to these beautiful animals and will learn from the experienced judges who have come from right across the country. WHEN: From 9am WHERE: MAIN ARENA

## DON'T BE SHEEPISH

One of the most popular competitions of the show kicks off tomorrow – the Sheep Dog Trial sponsored by Lendlease. Barry Knight and his two sons Bailey (18) and Charlie (16) are competing in the Sheepdog Trials at Ekka on the first Sunday of show. It's the very first time at Ekka a family has competed against each other in the Sheep Dog Trials. This is the family's first time at Ekka and they'll be competing against each other – some good old family rivalry! The competition was first held at Ekka in 1899, with the dogs judged on cast, approach, bridging, obstacle and general work. **WHEN: 12pm WHERE: Main**
