About 65,000 Queenslanders are estimated to have attended the Ekka today, a tradition since the very first Show holiday in 1876.

We had all creatures great and small in the Grand Parade; people boot scooting at the first Ekka Line Dancing Competition and the perfect People's Day temperature – 26 degrees.

Tomorrow will be another glorious Ekka day, and with only four more days to go, if you have not yet visited, now is the time to come on down and see what all the talk is about.
