

ROYAL QUEENSLAND SHOW (EKKA) PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PROMOTION	Australian National Anthem Singing Contest
PROMOTOR NAME	Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland (“RNA”). The RNA owns, manages and operates the event called the Royal Queensland Show (the “Ekka”)

PROMOTIONAL PERIOD	Opens on Tuesday 7 May 2019 at 9.00am AEST Concludes Sunday 30 June 2019 at 11.59pm AEST
VIDEO SOLICIT PERIOD	Opens on Tuesday 7 May 2019 at 9.00am AEST Concludes Sunday 30 June 2019 at 11.59pm AEST
ENTRY RESTRICTIONS	Entry is open to amateur and semi-professional artists only. A semi-professional is one who earns some money as a performer but is not dependent on such income for a living and hasn't toured professionally. Entrants under the age of 18 years must have a parent's or guardian's consent to enter.
MAXIMUM ENTRIES	One entry per person permitted – an entrant is only eligible to win one prize in the Promotion.
ENTRY PROCEDURE	To enter entrants must, during the Promotional Period, visit the Website and register their details via the online form. Entrants must submit a link to a YouTube video of them performing the Australian National Anthem (two verses) during the Video Solicit Period, and subscribe to the Ekka YouTube Channel. A backing track of the Australian National Anthem is available to download via the Website.
DRAW DETAILS	This is a game of skill and nine winners will be selected by the Entertainment Department of Ekka.
PRIZE DETAILS	Prize includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Singing on stage within the Main Arena at the 2019 Royal Queensland Show, Friday 9 August 2019 until Sunday 18 August 2019. • Double pass for entry into the Ekka for the day of their performance.
PRIZE RESTRICTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winners must be available to perform across ten nights of Show, Friday 9 August 2019 until Sunday 18 August 2019. • Winners are restricted to one prize per entrant, per household • No prize substitutions
NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS	Winners will be notified by telephone and/or email on Wednesday 10 July 2019.
PUBLICATION DETAILS	Winner(s) may be published on the website www.ekka.com.au
PRIZE CLAIM DETAILS	Prizes must be claimed at the time of the notification or as otherwise specified by the Promoter.
UNCLAIMED PRIZE ARRANGEMENTS	If a Prize is unclaimed, the Promoter serves the right to re-award the Prize as chosen by the Entertainment Department of the Ekka.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Royal Queensland Show and participating sponsors are not responsible for mutilated, mis-uploaded or late contest entries.
 - Winners are responsible for applicable travel and accommodation, if required.
 - Management reserves the right to limit or cancel any performances without notice. Depending on the availability of entrants, replacements for any cancellations may be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Late entries may not be accepted by Ekka Management.
 - Due to space restrictions, no instruments are permitted on stage during the performance. No pre-recorded backing music which includes midi or drum machines supplied by the performer may be used. No pre-recorded backing vocals by the performer will be permitted.
 - The winning performers must be in neat country dress. No singlets, shorts or thongs are to be worn on stage.
 - The winning performers must be present for the Safety Brief which will be located back of house of the Main Arena. Performers must present themselves to the Stage Manager thirty minutes prior to the safety briefing time. Although every effort will be made to adhere to the program, changes may be made at the discretion of the Royal Queensland Show Management.
 - Management will not be responsible for any loss or injury to persons or property throughout Ekka. Each performer shall not encourage any person/s up on stage. Each performer must behave professionally at all times. There is to be no swearing and artists must not perform songs that contain inappropriate themes or language or they may face disqualification.
 - Ekka has permission to take photographs of performers and has full copyright. Ekka reserves the right to use any images taken of performers on social media, websites, advertisements and any other format for marketing and publicity opportunities.
 - Ekka will have full control of all advertising either by radio/newspaper/flyers etc. Any performer wishing to advertise on their social media pages or websites may do so however you may not use the Ekka logo without prior approval.
 - There is no parking on the grounds; however there is ample public transport to and from the grounds and alternative parking is available within walking distance of the grounds.
