



## *Important Dates and Frequently Asked Questions*

### 1. When do cattle need to be delivered?

Class 38 – 70 day – Tuesday 6 April – Beef City Feedlot.

Class 37 and 40 – 100 day – Friday 5 March – Beef City Feedlot.

Class 39 – 400 day – Monday 19 April – Sapphire Feedlot.

### 2. When is judging?

Weight gain – 16 and 17 June.

Wagyu Taste Off – July 2022.

### 3. When is the Awards Presentation?

4 August (during Beef Week at Brisbane Showgrounds).

### 4. When are results available?

Results will be available online immediately after the awards presentation.

### 5. When are collections?

Wagyu striploins are available for collection at the awards presentation. If you require refrigerated transport this will need to be at your own cost.

## *Entering*

### 6. How much is it to enter?

\$245 for RNA members, \$265 for non-RNA members.

### 7. How do I enter?

Online via the competition portal - Click here to access the link. Exhibitors will be required to make a new account or log in to a pre-existing account to submit entries.

### 8. Can I enter twice into the same class?

Yes, you can enter up to 3 pens (of 7) in each class.

### 9. How do I know which class I need to enter?

Class 37 – 100 HGP

Class 38 – 70-day trade

Class 39 – 400-day Wagyu

Class 40 – 100-day HGP free

## *Delivery of Entries*

### 10. Where do I deliver my exhibit to?

Classes 37, 38 and 40 – Beef City Feedlot.

Class 39 – Smithfield Cattle Co's Sapphire Feedlot.

### 11. Do I need to accompany anything with my delivery?

Yes, NVDs. Allocated ear tags will already be affixed.

### 12. I have not received the ear tags. What do I do?
