Margaret's love for cats started with her "Teddy Bear" as hers was a real live Siamese and in hindsight must have been from the very first Siamese in Canterbury.

Herself and husband David did not actually apply for the "Iluka or Tartarus" Prefix until the mid-1980's, by which time had already been showing Pets for several years. Over the years they have bred and shown, Siamese & Orientals, Burmese & Mandalay's, British & Scottish Folds, with all the associated family groups for these breeds, Russian Blue & Whites, and 3 Exotic Neuters, they have both exported and imported many cats around the world.

Then Margaret became a Shorthair Judge followed up by completing further studies and achieving Senior All Breeds status. Everything went well with assignments all over Australia and NZ. National and Royal shows through to small club shows, all equally enjoyable and memorable.

That was until the 2010/11 Earthquake shook Christchurch. Their Cat breeding days were quite clearly over. Their cats were dispersed far and wide as their home was to need major repairs. It took over 5 years before their home was rebuilt. During this time Margaret needed to step away from Cats completely, so just under 3 years ago Margaret resigned as a Judge. Now their house and life has been rebuilt, Margaret has been accepted back as an All Breeds by NZCF.

Prior to moving to Murrumbateman, She has held various positions including the Secretary of QFA Inc., Secretary of the Birman Cat Fanciers of Qld Club and President of the Gold Coast Cat Club.

She and her husband are enjoying their life in Murrumbateman and share their home with their Birmans, and three Alpacas Cherokee, Magic and Warlock. Aside from her cat related activities she enjoys patchwork quilting, web site development, travelling and spending time with the grandchildren.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that all entries that are accepted will be subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971, as well as to the By-Laws, General Regulations of the Association and any Competition Specific Regulations which appear in this schedule.

Judging will be performed by a panel of Judges appointed by the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland.

No refunds will be made after close of entry. No refunds will be given for entries not presented or not adhering to the schedule regulations.

If COVID-19 recommendations and mandates advised by the Federal and State Governments mean the competition class you entered cannot proceed in 2021, the RNA will issue a full refund of your entry fee.

NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

Entries for EKKA 2021 can ONLY be made online through our [Exhibitor Portal](#). Entries submitted other than on the online portal will be returned to the Exhibitor and, unless all requirements are submitted online by 5.00pm on the Application to Enter closing date, as shown in the Schedule, they will not be considered.

As a condition for acceptance of all entries, all exhibitors/competitors agree to the following:

- All information submitted as part of my exhibitor profile is true and correct, including taxation status and bank account information.
- Neither myself nor my family members will indulge in any social, professional or other interaction with an official or judge contracted or sub- contracted by the RNA before or during the Royal Queensland Show.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

You can be assured that the privacy of your personal information is of the utmost importance to us. The information provided by you in any application for membership or application to enter is used by the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland (RNA) to offer member services or to organize and conduct competitions at the Royal Queensland Show. By applying for membership or entering such competitions you consent to provide such details as your name, address and exhibit details. Competition information may be made available to the media and included in RNA publications.

The exhibitor irrevocably consents to the RNA publishing or reproducing in any manner whatsoever any particulars or information in relation to their exhibits; the publication or reproduction may be in a printed form or visual image through electronic means and/or on the internet. Your information will not be disclosed without your consent for any other purpose unless required by the law. By providing your email address you are consenting to receive communications from us relating to the Royal Queensland Show. PRIZE MONEY

1. Prize Money stated in the Schedule excludes GST.
2. GST will be added to the Prize Money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. Prize money will be paid into your nominated bank account by 31 October following the Show.
3. The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.
4. All cash prizes and trophies must be claimed within six months from the closing date of the Royal Queensland Show. Prizes not claimed and by that date will be considered to have lapsed, and the amount will become a donation to the Association. (RNA By-Laws)

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

1. The Brisbane Showgrounds are a designated Workplace within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors/competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or sub-contractors, comply with all requirements of the Act and the RNA holds each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor of any area of the Showgrounds.
2. Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, RNA staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.
3. Risks identified by exhibitors/competitors will be eliminated or controlled by the exhibitor/competitor and particular attention will be paid to ensuring public safety and safety of other exhibitors/competitors.
4. Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. A "No Smoking Policy" will be strictly adhered to and policed by exhibitors/competitors and all are advised that the use of Primus stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in the pavilions.
6. Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited, and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.
7. All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the Act and its Regulations and Standards in every other respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Anyone who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Royal Queensland Show.
8. The Brisbane Showgrounds is subject to a Special Facility License issued under the Liquor Act 1992 and strict laws related to the consumption and possession of liquor across the Brisbane Showgrounds site. The consumption or possession of liquor outside of the licensed bar areas is not authorized by the RNA and in many cases may be an offence for which on the spot fines can be issued by Police and Liquor Licensing Investigators.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

132. It there is any inconsistency between By-laws 133 - 153 and any other By-laws of the Association, By-laws 133 - 153 will prevail.
133. The functions of the Disciplinary Committee shall be to hear and determine all complaints, allegations and other matters relating to:
- a) prohibited substances, as defined in these By-laws or Sectional Regulations.
 - b) any alleged breach of the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Association by an exhibitor and relating to an exhibit or to a competition, except if the alleged breach is of a kind that the Chairman of a Sectional Committee considers is of a less serious nature and should properly be dealt with by the Sectional Committee, and
 - c) any other alleged breach of the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Association that may be referred to Disciplinary Committee pursuant to By-Law 137 (a).
147. The Disciplinary Committee may announce its decision orally or in writing. A decision that is announced orally shall have effect in accordance with its terms.
148. If the opinion of the Disciplinary Committee is not unanimous, the decision of the majority shall prevail. If the Disciplinary Committee are equally divided on any question concerning the guilt or innocence of a person, the question shall be resolved in that person's favour.
149. If the Disciplinary Committee considers that there has been a breach of the rules, By-laws or regulations of the Association, it may impose such a penalty as it considers to be appropriate, including without limitation:
- a) a reprimand.
 - b) a monetary fine (payable at such time/s as the Disciplinary Committee may determine)
 - c) withdrawal or withholding of any award or ribbon.
 - d) disqualification in respect of any class.
 - e) expulsion from the Showground.
 - f) where the person concerned is a member, a suspension or termination of that membership.
 - g) a ban.
 - h) exclusion.
 - i) prohibiting a Person from exhibiting or competing at the current Show or at any future Show.
 - j) a direction that an Exhibit be removed from the Showground.
 - k) any other mandatory requirement; and
 - l) any other penalty provided for in other regulations of the Association.
150. There shall be no appeal from any decision of the Disciplinary Committee.

INSURANCE

161. The RNA may (but is not obliged to) take out a policy of insurance in respect of the legal liability on the part of an Exhibitor for loss or damage suffered by a third party caused by any act or omission of an Exhibit or the Exhibitor.
162. The RNA, RNA Staff Members and Officials of the RNA are not liable to any Exhibitor if the RNA fails to take out a policy of insurance effectively protecting any Exhibitor or Exhibit, or if any such policy does not operate to indemnify the Exhibitor in respect of the loss or damage in question.

REGULATIONS & BY-LAWS

All Entries and Exhibitors are subject to RNA Regulations and By-Laws set out in this schedule as well as other By-Laws that may pertain to this competition.

The RNA always reserves the right at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason to:

- a) substitute a Judge when necessary.
- b) re-allocate Judging days for a particular breed.
- c) if entries numbers require an extra Judge, appoint an additional Judge if necessary.

Full copies of the RNA By-Laws may be obtained upon application to the Competitions Department.

CAT COMPETITION

REGULATIONS

1. Judging will commence at 9.30am.
2. All Cats are to be benched by 8:30am each day and remain on exhibit to 5:00pm.
3. Only the owner or their representative may remove the exhibit at the end of the day.
4. If the exhibitor arrives after the stipulated benching time, and judging has commenced, then the exhibitor will forfeit being judged in that Ring and must wait until the judge has completed judging before benching their exhibit.
5. Any cat entered for competition and present at the Show may not be withdrawn from competition without the consent of the Councillor in Charge.
6. Prize Cards and Ribbons won at the current Royal Queensland Show may be displayed once judging is completed. Any Ribbons won outside of this Show cannot be displayed.
7. Should any question arise for which no specific guidance is provided; the matter shall be referred to the Councillor in charge whose decision on the matter shall be final.
8. It is an offence for any person to remove or alter the location of any exhibit from the cages allocated. Failure to observe this requirement may result in withdrawal of the exhibits. You are required to seek prior approval from the Councillor in Charge before any changes are made.
9. Any exhibit, if found to be entered in the wrong class, will be transferred to the correct class.
10. No kitten under the age of twelve (12) weeks is permitted to be shown.
11. All exhibits (except Companion Cats) must be registered, and registration numbers listed on the application to enter.
12. A photocopy of each exhibit's registration certificate must be uploaded as part of each application.
13. Entries for exhibits registered with any other Australian body other than ACF or CCCA affiliates must be accompanied by a 4-generation pedigree. Entries must be received in sufficient time to allow the registrar to verify that the exhibits pedigree conforms to ACF breeding guidelines.
14. Registration pending will not be accepted.
15. No Exhibit will be reclassified for colour or pattern at the Show.
16. Any exhibit found to have colouring matter or powder will be disqualified. No grooming is to be done on Judging Tables.
17. All exhibits must have claws clipped (front and back).

18. All exhibits must be entered in Show with information (including colour and pattern) as detailed on their registration certificate. Exhibits must be judged according to this information. Adult exhibits (9 months and over) CANNOT be reclassified for colour or pattern. Kittens may be reclassified before judging or during the first ring of judging with the owner's consent on the understanding that the kitten cannot be changed again for the duration of the show.
19. Any exhibit showing fractious or aggressive behaviour to being handled in any ring will be disqualified from all rings.
20. Exhibitors with their exhibits must enter and exit the showgrounds via Gate 2 before and after show. Details pertaining to drop off and collection procedures will be advised to exhibitors closer to show.
21. All Exhibits will only be allowed onto the Showgrounds if in a carriage container.
22. All Exhibitors must supply their own coloured cage curtains and provide own cage or hire cage available.

Approved show cage measurements for people purchasing their own cages are:
Small: 62.5cm Wide x 46.0cm Deep x 52.0cm High
Large: 78.9cm Wide x 48.3cm Deep x 56.0cm High
23. The cages must be lined on both sides and the back with a solid material (e.g. polyflute) to prevent cats from having contact with other cats. Exhibitors may place this liner inside the cage or affix it securely to the outside.
24. Cage hire available at a cost of \$12.00 per cage.
25. Any complaint must be in writing and must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 and must be lodged within seven (7) days of the last day of Show.

HOW TO ENTER

Entries for 2021 must be made online at the [Online Entries Portal](#)

Entry submissions must include all requirements as shown in the Schedule before being submitted to the competition. Entries that do not include all the correct information after the Entries Close date are liable to be disqualified from the competition with no refund of entry fees.

PASS ALLOCATION

Competitor Entry Passes will be allocated to Exhibitors on the following basis for each day of exhibiting:

- 1 to 4 entries – 2 passes
- 5 to 6 entries – 4 passes
- 7 or more entries – 6 passes

These passes will be sent out in the weeks leading up to the Show.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

A report of outstanding vaccination certificates should be given to Council Steward to ensure the exhibitor meets this requirement.

Every kitten entered into the show must provide with the entry form a copy of its current F3 (or equivalent) vaccination certificate or documentation.

First vaccination must have been given at least 14 days prior to the show. The certificate or documentation must be signed by the person who administered the vaccine and include the vaccine sticker label with date given and the kitten's breed, colour, sex and DOB. If on exhibition the certificate needs to be provided to the Honorary Council Steward on arrival.

AGE

The age of all Exhibits will be the actual age as at the first day of the Show.

Kittens must be at least twelve (12) weeks and under nine (9) months of age. Kittens must be born between 6 November 2020 to 15 May 2021, with these dates inclusive. NO ENTRIES UNDER 12 WEEKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Cats must be nine (9) months of age and over, born on or before 7 November 2020.
