OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY

When: 12.30pm - 1.30pm. Where: Main Arena

Enjoy the pomp and ceremony of the official Opening Ceremony as the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia welcomes Ekka guests from across the state. The Governor-General of Australia will officially declare the 143rd show open, with the ceremony also including a traditional blessing of the plough, a performance by the Australian Army Band Brisbane, special aerial display by the Royal Australian Air Force Roulettes (at 1.10pm), and a livestock parade featuring some of the country's best stud beef cattle.

CHIPS TO FLY AT THE WOODCHOP

When: 9am - 5pm. Where: Woodchop Arena

The iconic Woodchop and Sawing Competition has been held at the Ekka for more than a century. Axemen and women of all ages compete in this popular competition – some are even fourth generation. A highlight is the kids' competition which includes the Under 13s invitational 250mm Underhand Final from 1pm on Sunday 7 August.

When: 12pm to 2pm. Where: XXXX Stockmen's Bar and Grill

Have you ever seen clogging? It's a type of folk dance where the dancer's shoes are used to create a rhythm. The Confi*dance* Cloggers will perform at the Ekka for the very first time. They teach this energetic dance form in Brisbane and across Australia.
