Dave Graham is a farmer and professional animal behaviourist from southwest Queensland, but is best known for his work as a presenter and spokesperson. Dave appeared on 2006 and 2022 Big Brother, Australia's Got Talent and he MCs across Australia. His genuine Aussie banter and depth of knowledge brings an authentic feel that puts audiences at ease and engages them with a larrikin sense of humour.

THE BISON STAMPEDE BATTLE IN THE SADDLE PRESENTED BY DAVE MANCHON

Everyone's favourite equine artist Dave Manchon is back with a brand new stampede show - Battle in the Saddle. Think cowboys, cowgirls, two stepping, galloping horses, bison, long horn bulls and all things Yellow Stone. The show features an Aussie stockman versus American cowboy challenge to determine who really does run the West. Families will love the spectacle as the cowboys and cowgirls introduce them to around 20 large bison, that are only usually seen on TV and movie screens. Never to be outmatched, the audience will also witness the skill of the Australian Stock Horses as they gallop against the power of the American Quarter Horse. Sit tight for an all-action show!



QUEENSLAND HARNESS RACING PRESENTED BY RACING QUEENSLAND

Nightly harness racing at the Ekka has been a show staple. The legendary trots featured at the Show until 2002 - they then made a comeback in 2014 and have been tearing around the Main Arena ever since. The Garrards Finale will be held on the last night of show (Sunday 20 August).

CHARIOT MOTORBIKE RACING

You've seen the harness racing, now watch on as the Flair Action Sports Chariot Bikes race around the Main Arena with a different kind of horse power. One person will steer and control two motorcycles from far behind the handlebars, as they compete to be crowned the Chariot King. These custom-made vehicles are powered by two Husqvarna 401 motorcycles each and they look and sound incredible! The first ever competition of motorcycle chariot racing was held in the USA as early as 1922, gaining popularity throughout the 1920s and 1930s and further inspired by the 1925 film Ben-Hur. Cheer on your favourite chariot bike as the fierce racers go head to head.

Jack Field

This former world number one freestyle trials champion is a serious daredevil. He performed the highest backflip on a motorcycle ever recorded, backflipping 297m in the air without safety barriers on top of the Eureka Tower in Melbourne. Jack doubled for Vin Diesel in XXX movie, fought Hugh Jackman on a motorbike in Wolverine and appeared in Mad Max in Namibia.

Brad Jenner

Brad is an international freestyle trials rider and movie stunt performer. He has travelled throughout Australia showcasing heart pumping live stunt shows and performing for more than a million spectators annually at some of the world's biggest events. Brad has also been a stunt performer alongside Hollywood actor Chris Hemsworth! Whether it's a two wheeled, four wheeled or even six wheeled bike or contraption, Brad will keep you on the edge of your seat.

V8 UTE CHALLENGE PRESENTED BY THE TRACKSKILL MOVIE STUNT DRIVERS

It's the age old battle between two Australian icons – Ford and Holden. With plenty of colour, big V8 noise and sideways action, this high adrenaline show is sure to be a huge hit with families. From the days of Peter Brock and Dick Johnson to the present day of the Camaro and Mustangs, Aussies have loved that screaming V8 sound as the drivers race to dominate the podiums. Our two Trackskill drivers won't hold back, as they fight to uphold the honour of their beloved marque.

Gary Baxter

Gary is one of Australia's leading drivers and has been competing in various classes for more than 20 years. He's a two-time Australian ROH Wheels Commodore Cup Champion, having taken out the series in both 1995 and 1996. Gary stunt drives regularly in movies and television commercials, with his resume including Ricky Stanicky starring Zac Efron, Wolf Creek TV (series 1 and 2) and Storm Boy.

Tim Ramages

Tim is a professional performance driver and trainer who has worked on movies including Mortal Kombat. He started his career in Gravel Rally (Australian Rally Championship) at a state and national level in the early 1990s, moving onto drifting and competing in the Tarmac Rally. Tim has won many races in the Tarmac Rally and has taken out multiple top five stage times in Gravel Rally.



WHEELS OF STEEL

Presenting for the first time in Australian history, not one, not two but three Wheels of Steel performing simultaneously inside the Main Arena. No safety nets, no harnesses - all adrenaline! Weighing 800kg and standing three storeys tall, performers rely solely upon their skills to maintain balance atop the rotating steel pendulums. The Wheel of Steel is considered one of the most dangerous stunts to perform. Ekka guests will be on the edge of their seats as international circus performers run, jump, skip and perform acrobatics on a rotating wheel that is only 60cm wide.

Warren Brophy



Warren is a seventh generation circus artist. He started performing at a young age with his family's circus, Perry Bros, travelling around Australia. Warren was able to learn many different skills including lasso spinning, tightrope, knife throwing and of course the Wheel of Steel which he fell in love with. Throughout his 20s, Warren has toured this act at major events around Australia and headlined international shows.

Jansen Grant

Jansen is seventh generation in the Ashton circus family. He started performing at just four years old and at 13 became the youngest person in the world to perform the Wheel of Steel. Other acts Jansen has performed include the flying trapeze (as both a flyer and a catcher), clowning, acrobatics and working with various animals.



Tim Matousek



Tim has been performing in the circus for the past 15 years. His skills include the Wheel of Steel, Russian swing, aerial straps, Chinese pole and many more. Tim has performed in various touring shows around Australia and Europe. He loves the roar of the crowd and loves to entertain.

The riders will launch motorcycles an incredible 15 metres into the air while performing some of the most death defying stunts in the industry! Boasting a career spanning more than 20 years as a professional MC, singer, actor and Hollywood stunt driver, Tommy G is a man of many talents - from two wheeling a stunt car one minute to fight scenes as Batman the next! He is also undoubtably one of the best FMX announcers in the world.

Brad Wings' Burch - FMX Rider

Growing up on a dairy farm in country Victoria and forming a passion for jumping dirt bikes from a young age, Brad was born to fly. His Freestyle Motocross career exploded in 2009 when he received a full-time ride with the original Showtime FMX Team, quickly followed by the premiere of the Nitro Circus Live Tours in 2010. Performing more than 90 days per



year, he's spent the last 14 years touring Australia, Europe, Asia and America, alongside the very best in Action Sports, and is one of the most experienced FMX Show riders in the world.

Kain 'Raptor' Saul - FMX Rider



One of the first people in the world to backflip a dirt bike, Kain has done it all. The 2008 Australasian Freestyle Champion has spent his career performing full-time for the Showtime/ Airtime FMX Team, touring the world with Nitro Circus Live, and was part of the famous Crusty Demons. Kain is also a Guinness World Record Holder as the first person to backflip a Harley Davidson.

Ben 'Bulls Eye' Richards - FMX Rider

The hottest new talent to come out of Australia in the world of Freestyle Motocross, and the newest member of the Airtime FMX Team, Benny is excited to be making his debut at the 2023 Ekka. The 22 year old Wagga Wagga native already has a huge list of achievements including touring worldwide with Nitro Circus Live, representing Australia



at the Olympics of Action Sports, the X Games, and placing 3rd in FMX at the recent 2022 Nitro World Games. Known for his "spot on" style and execution, he enjoys being the centre of attention. Bulls Eye.
